In March, we started Hope 4 Kids as an outreach to the community. Every other Monday we meet to play games, sing songs, tell a missionary story, and teach a Bible lesson. This past Monday was our largest group so far with four kids and their parents from the reservation in attendance as well as our family. Our goal is to reach families through this ministry. GoMission Conference

March 28-31, we held our first GoMission Conference at Hope Baptist Church. We were joined by our Navajo brother, Dheidrick Hobbs and his wife, Joetta. They are on deputation to plant a church on the Navajo Reservation. Bro. Hobbs presented his mission field and preached very straight-forward messages. On Saturday of the Conference, the Hobbs, my family, and Tyler went knocking on doors in the town of White Earth. We had a great time getting the gospel out. A big victory was to see Tyler go out soulwinning with us. She continues to hunger after God and it is exciting to see her want to tell others about Jesus. At the end of the conference, we took the Hobbs on for financial support! We are excited to partner with them as natives reaching natives with the gospel!

Bible Meeting

Last week we had a three-day Bible meeting with Evangelist David Barker with Scripture Memory Ministries. He was a tremendous blessing to everyone each service in teaching how to read your Bible and how to memorize Scripture.

Spiritual Battles

In the midst of God working, we have also taken notice of the spiritual battles that have been taking place in the church people, around the church building, and in our own personal lives. There has been an increase of spiritual oppression against our ministry and our family. At times it has been very heavy on us and spiritually exhausting for my family. Being around a culture that embraces the spirit world has opened our eyes to seeing this demonic activity in a real way.
