Vacation Bible School

In July, we had our Vacation Bible School at Hope Baptist Church. We were joined by Crownpoint Baptist Church from the Navajo Nation. Pastor Aaron Nelson brought a group of hard-working Navajos to reach our Ojibwe people. With their help, the majority of doors in the towns of White Earth and Ogema received gospel tracts and VBS flyers. Our VBS this year was a baseball theme with the emphasis on John 3:16 "For God so loved the world." The first night of VBS was a challenge because of a new playground dedication cookout in White Earth; however, we did have three children come. The second night we had 16 kids and one adult stay for the entire night. Two girls accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior on the second night! The third night we had also had a group of 16. We praise the Lord for two souls that were saved and the many that heard the gospel! We are looking forward to doing VBS again next summer! If your church would be interested in helping out with VBS next year please let me know in the near future so we can plan accordingly.

Missions Retreat

Every year the Independent Baptist Indian Mission, Inc. (IBIMI) holds a missions retreat for the families that are part of the agency. This year we had the privilege of hosting the meetings. On September 1st, we are celebrating the 3rd anniversary of Hope Baptist Church! Pastor Caleb Mitchell, the pastor of Walworth Baptist Church, started Hope in 2021 and will be our guest preacher for our anniversary service. Pray that we will have a really good turnout!

Our auditorium still needs some work done in order to be completely finished. The church is working towards purchasing flooring for our auditorium and the platform. If anyone would be interested in helping us with this project after we purchase the flooring, please let me know.
