We are less than a month away from the arrival our baby girl! Our family is looking forward to meeting the new daughter that God has blessed us with. Pray for a healthy delivery for mom and baby. Pray for my wife to have strength in these final days of pregnancy.

### Preaching, Teaching, and Special Prayer

In September, I took the month to preach and teach on stewardship. Much of what was preached was completely new to our people and contradicts the lifestyles of many of them, but I trust that God worked in all of our lives to be good stewards of His blessings.

On October 3<sup>rd</sup> had a well-attended Chili Cook-off fellowship with some returning visitors. We are also looking forward to our Hallelujah Night service on October 31<sup>st</sup> where we will have a special time of praising our risen Savior, preaching the gospel and enjoying a candy buffet. Many of our people do not read the Bible or know how to get in the Bible. Coming to church is more of a religious practice rather following Jesus in His Word. After the message, we are practicing sword drills as a way to teach people how to find each book, chapter, and verse for themselves.
