Some of the men from their church will be coming back in July to lay flooring down in our auditorium and do a basketball evangelistic outreach near the church building. As I went to reintroduce myself, she immediately begins to ask for help to open the trunk of her car. Her trunk latch had broken and it had groceries in it. Long story short, Bro. Ryan was able to go through the back seat and make a temporary fix to her trunk. As a result of our "trunk" evangelism we were able to see this lady Faith and her daughter Marylin come to church on that Sunday. Pray for their salvation!

Easter Sunday

On Easter Sunday, I preached from Matthew 28:1-9 on The Reality of Jesus' Resurrection. We had our largest Sunday attendance with 24! There were two new families in attendance. One of these families are praying about coming regularly! The husband and wife have clear salvation testimonies and they have adopted seven reservation kids from 6 to 19 years old that come from rough abusive home situations. Due to some of the abuse that some of the children have faced in White Earth they are being cautious with the kids if they should commit to going church in White Earth. Pray that the Lord will give them wisdom where they should be for church. This would be a huge answer to prayer if they were to join us!
