We have been very busy through these months with the new Church plant in the village of Euan. It's about an hour drive from where we live. We have prayer meetings every Tuesday evening in the people's homes. On Thursdays, we have Discipleship Classes. We have between 6-8 regulars that attend these classes. There are some that are coming that we believe are not saved, but we are praying that God will work through these classes. We are lingering long over the lessons dealing with Salvation. They have been so indoctrinated with Catholicism. It takes many hours of teaching and just showing them the truth of God's Word. We have begun Sunday Night services here at the beginning of this year.

Our main hub Church, Resurrection Baptist, just moved in to the new building. What a blessing! We are excited about the space this building affords! We run about 150-170 people in a service, and with the children's classes, teen classes and everything, it was getting very tight in the old building. We plan to start a seminary, together with our team, this year. This will be for anyone interested in a deeper knowledge of the Bible, but specifically to train those that God is calling in to the ministry. (2 Timothy 2:2) The goal is to expand even more into these surrounding villages and to train these men to fill the pulpits, as God is calling them.

The church in the village of Nohuayun is doing great. They are growing in the Lord and the meal center for the children is fruitful!



We came to the states December the 2nd. It has been a great trip out. We have been able to spend some time with family and our home church. We were also able to visit 2 new churches, as well as a few supporting churches that were close-by. There were so many other supporting churches that wanted us to come by, and we simply didn't have the time. We love every time we get to visit each of you, and we are sorry for the times it just doesn't work out. Thank you all for your love and understanding! God blessed us so much in allowing two new churches to take us on for support this year. We appreciate Bro. Jonathan Barker and Amazing Grace Baptist, as well as, Bro. Jason Flowers and New Home Missionary Baptist! What a wonderful thing it is to have each one of our churches holding the rope for us. We are truly humbled!

Another purpose for us coming out, was to get our middle son settled here at home. He will not be returning with us. We thank God for giving him a great job and a place to stay. He's involved at our home church and doing well. Please be in prayer for our family through these transitions in the days ahead.
