Thanksgiving always reminds me of the many blessings the Lord has graciously given our family, and Christmas provides a special opportunity to celebrate our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We are grateful for every opportunity the Lord gives us to share the good news of Jesus Christ and to testify of what He has done in our lives.

We were thankful to spend the holidays with our families this year, especially knowing that our time together in the coming years will look much different. It was a sweet and meaningful season, and we are incredibly blessed to have families who are so supportive of the calling God has placed on our lives.

We would also like to express our sincere gratitude to our church family at Freedom Fellowship Baptist Church for the overwhelming love and support they have shown us. Our commissioning service was held on December 7th, and the care of our church family was evident through the hugs shared, tears shed, and prayers lifted on our behalf. The preaching that day was both encouraging and challenging to our family and to the church as a whole. We are truly thankful to be sent out as an extension of such a God-loving church.

Additionally, we want to extend a special thank you to our supporting churches that gave extra during the Christmas season. Your generosity was a tremendous blessing to our family, and we are deeply grateful for your continued support and faithfulness.

Although we were able to enjoy additional time with our families over the last few months, we remained busy with meetings. During November and December, we traveled to churches in Virginia, Florida, Alabama, New Jersey, and Missouri. We thank the Lord for His continued protection and provision throughout our deputation travels. We are excited to share that we have reached 95% of our needed support. We are waiting to hear back from several churches in 2026 and are trusting the Lord to provide the remaining five percent in His perfect timing.

While our family has completed deputation together, I will be visiting three additional churches on my own in Canada. I will be traveling to Calgary this week to meet with several churches, including one pastored by a Romanian missionary. Please keep these meetings in your prayers as I look forward to seeing what the Lord will do. During this time, Emily and the children will be visiting her family one final time before our departure for Romania.

We are incredibly thankful for the Shrock family, who have already been such a help to us as we prepare for our move to Romania. They were instrumental in assisting us with securing a rental home upon our arrival. We had several specific needs and desires for housing, and the Lord graciously provided a place that met every one of them. I am continually reminded that He truly cares about the desires of our hearts.

We have also begun taking Romanian language lessons online with the instructor we will study under once we arrive. Our goal is to gain a basic foundation in the language to help with everyday communication and to begin classes at a more conversational level. Please pray for Emily and me as we learn this new language—that the Lord would give us clarity, focus, and perseverance as we prepare for this next step.

Since our last prayer letter, we have purchased our tickets to Romania and are scheduled to depart the United States on February 17th. Please keep our family in prayer on that day. It will be a heavy moment as we say "see you later" to loved ones and navigate international travel with four young children. We are confident that the Lord will sustain us and provide the strength we need.

As I close this letter, it is exciting to realize that this will be the last update written from the United States. The next letter you receive will be written from Romania in 2026. Thank you again for your continued prayers and support. We truly could not do this without you.
